



**Regulation of the Rector
of the University of Economy in Bydgoszcz
of 02/11/2021
on information obligations in connection
with the escalation of the SARS – CoV – 2 pandemic**

In connection with Article 17.8 of the Act of 2 March 2020 on special solutions related to the prevention, counteraction and combating of COVID-19, other infectious diseases and crisis situations caused by them (Journal of Laws item 374, as amended), it is ordered as follows:

§ 1

Foreigners coming from abroad to study at the University of Economy are obliged to observe sanitary discipline and to inform the University's authorities about their travel route, including the places of changes, the current address at which they are staying in Poland, other contact details as well as about their intention to move out of the region, the borders of Poland or the Schengen zone.

§2

Students of the University of Economy staying at the student dormitory should strictly follow the general epidemiological rules and the specific sanitary rules defined for the place of residence. In a situation of suspicion or infection with SARS-CoV-2 and being in quarantine/self-isolation, they should immediately inform the administrator of the student dormitory about this situation, according to the *Declaration of a person referred to live in the student dormitory of the University of Economy*, constituting an annex to the Rector's Regulation of October 1, 2021 on educational processes, including the organisation of teaching activities in connection with the prevention, counteraction and eradication of COVID-19 in the academic year 2021/2022.

§ 3

The provisions of §1 and §2 shall apply respectively to students who stay at the University of Economy within the Erasmus+ Programme or other international programmes and agreements implemented by the University.

§4

The detailed procedure to be followed in the case of suspicion of SARS-CoV-2 infection is defined in the document entitled "*Algorithm of action in case of suspicion of SARS-CoV-2 infection*", which is available in the Public Information Bulletin of the University of Economy, under the tab "Safety".

§ 5

This Regulation becomes effective upon signing.
